

Parking Facilities Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Where is monthly parking available?**

- 2. How much is parking downtown?**
Parking rates vary by location, time of day, and/or the scheduling of a special event. Monthly rates vary from \$25 to \$150. Daily rates vary from \$1.50 to \$15. Rates for specific facilities can be obtained by calling 513-352-4527 during normal business hours.
- 3. How do I report a broken parking meter?**
The City's Parking Enforcement and Meter Repair Section can be reached at 513-352-4527.
- 4. What is the height clearance of a garage?**
Most City facilities have a 6-foot-6-inch clearance.
- 5. How do I complain about a private parking operator?**
Violations are investigated by the City's Public Vehicle Section at 513-352-3708.
